## Art Contest Rules

The contest is open to all youth k through 12 grades from homeschool, public, private schools or church school, scout, or JROTC or young marine type groups.

Cash prizes of \$25 for first place, \$15 for second place and \$10 for third place winners, will be given in each of these categories:

1) k - 3rd, 2) 4 - 8th grade, 3) 9 - 12 grade.

- 1) All artwork must be original and done by the person who is printing their name, age, grade, address and school on the back of their artwork. Do not put your name on the front.
- 2) All artwork must include your conception of the flag house, the 15 star American flag and have "The flag house" printed or written on the front of your work.
- 3) Finger paint, crayons, tempera, acrylic, collage, pencil, charcoal, pen and ink allowed. Size no larger than 8.5" x 11" - 22 cm x 28 cm.
- 4) Place entry into envelope with cardboard, "Do not bend" written on the front and have postmarked by February 1, 2016 to:

- 5) Winners will be decided by members attending the NYS Annual Conference in 2016, by ballot. Decisions are final. All entries become the property of the State of NY Society's Flag House & Star-Spangled Banner Museum Committee.
